How does this year deliver your curriculum intent?

In Year 11, students examine the structure and function of health and social care services, alongside the values that underpin professional practice. This component supports the curriculum intent by fostering a commitment to excellence in care standards through the study of compassion, respect, empowerment and safeguarding.
