Year 11 GCSE Updates

Each student has been provided with a bespoke Achieve timetable (which has also been shared with parents and carers via ClassCharts), which outlines the sessions students are expected to attend to ensure they are fully prepared for each examination, including weekend and May Half Term sessions. On the morning before each examination, students are invited to attend Prepare to Achieve sessions from 7.30am, where breakfast will be provided, and subject experts will be on hand to support final preparations and answer any questions. Additional marginal gains are also in place to support students, including water bottles, sweets and pens specifically chosen by each individual student.

I would once again like to take the opportunity to remind parents and carers of the uniform expectations below.

Uniform standards remain exemplary, and we thank students for following the uniform policy. As part of the high standards set out in the uniform policy, there are expectations for makeup and jewellery. Make-up should not be noticeable and should always be light, natural looking and discreet. Dark highlighted eyebrows, bright coloured lipstick, dark foundation, highlighter, fake tan, painted nails, nail extensions, gel nails or false eyelashes are not allowed to be worn under any circumstances. The only item of jewellery permitted is a watch. This item must be removed for practical activities. No jewellery permitted including earrings, rings, spacer piercing retainers or tongue/nose piercings.
