How does this year deliver your curriculum intent?

Y10 Students will complete the controlled assessment (Unit 2: ICT in Context) of WJEC ICT. This will give students the opportunity to develop their skills on the 4 main software used in employment: Word Processing, Database, Spreadsheet and Graphics. Students will be able to build up their experience in creating systems and interrogate similar to the processes used in most modern organisations making them highly employable in the digitally led workplace. Students will bank 60% of their final grade via this assignment, with the remaining 40% being awarded through an external examination in Year 11. This will be an on-screen examination based on (Unit 1) ICT in Society.
