Bridging Project

This week we had our final Bridging Project session. The students enjoyed a Computer Studies lesson with Miss Cook. During this lesson, students explored Graphics Manipulation. Our enthusiastic students, who are fully invested and curious learners, looked at how multiple images can make up one graphic. Once students understood this concept, students designed two characters, on paper, using the internet for research and WAGOLLs, for their "animal holiday". They then used graphic manipulation software to create their scene, including an appropriate background for their characters. The students' work was exemplary, and Miss Cook was impressed by how hard these students work with a range of tools to ensure their graphics met the brief. It has been a pleasure to have such polite, hard-working, and curious students in our academy for these sessions and we cannot wait to welcome them to our academy in September.
