Dear Parent/Carer,
With 11 school weeks remaining until the start of external GCSE examinations for our year 11 s , we wanted to write to you with some key information and updates.


#### Abstract

Aftendance As shared in previous communication, attendance is a key factor in achievement and success at the end of year 11. As an Academy, we know that students who have attendance of above the Academy target of $97 \%$ throughout the year have consistently outperformed those whose attendance has been below this number.

It is vital that students attend every possible day from now until the end of the year. Within lessons, students will now be starting live trial examinations, examination preparation and key knowledge recap all of which will ensure that students are prepared and understand what is expected of them in their final examinations.


As parents/carers, we request that you continue to ensure your child attends the Academy every day.

## Trial Examinations

Within the next half term all year 11 students will take part in the next (and final) round of trial examinations. This includes both written examinations and practical examinations.

These examinations will take place over a four-week period as outlined below.
Within this, there are some achieve days to support success in ICT, a performance to support with English literature and a photography external visit.

It is essential that students are in the Academy with full investment for the entirety of this period to ensure that in the run up to their final examinations we are tailoring revision and examination support to their individual needs.

Following the examinations, we will be holding a results evening for the students and parents/carers to attend. This will be on Tuesday $26^{\text {th }}$ March from 5:30-6:30pm. This will enable all students to receive their results from the trial examinations and allow us to launch our summer Achieve timetable with you to outline and discuss how we will be supporting the students until their final examination.
