Year 13 Visit to Maltby

As part of the A Level Geography course students are required to make several field visits. As part of this process, it is important that we visit locations with both a human and physical focus. It also makes sense to ensure that the locations chosen are ones that link to case studies that are studied in lesson.

As such I would like to visit Maltby with students. We will carry out a walking tour of the location to identify how the lived experience of the location has changed over time.

The visit will take place on Friday 15th March between 9.15am and 12.35pm. Students should make their own way there to meet outside the entrance to Maltby Academy on the pedestrian path for the time mentioned above. At the end of the visit students will make their own way back to school or home as is appropriate to their timetable. Careful consideration of public transport should be made prior to the visit to ensure a prompt start.

Students will require a comfortable pair of footwear and have clothing appropriate for the weather forecast. They should also have a drink and something to eat. (There will not be any opportunities for students to purchase food on the visit.) Students will require a range of equipment which will allow them to record information on the visit including stationary, camera and paper. As such a small bag would be useful for carrying these items.
