### Thursday

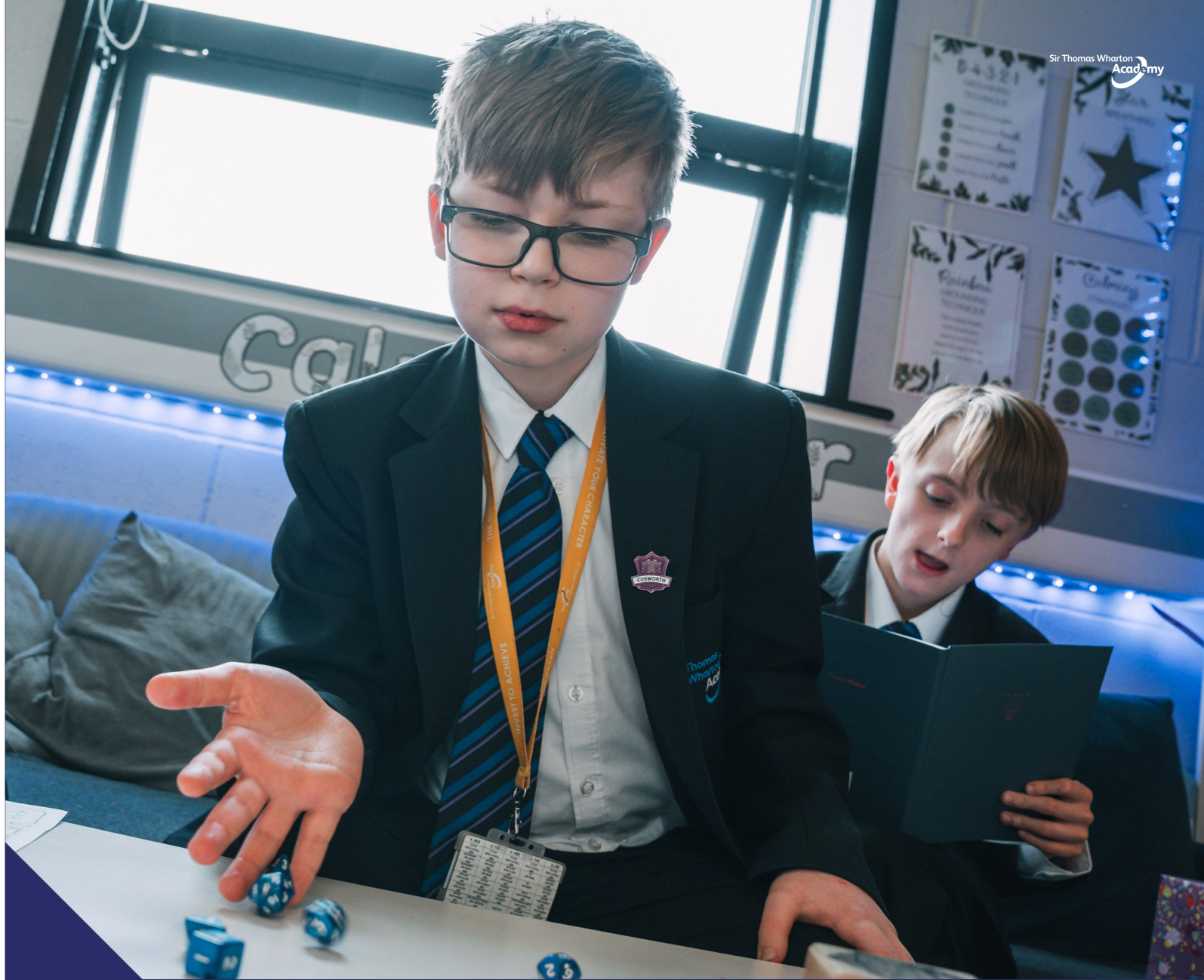
