Attendance

Attendance continues to be a strength of the academy and our new Y7 cohort have started strongly with an attendance of 98.8%. We will always strive for 100% attendance from every one of our young people to ensure they experience exceptional learning experiences daily which will ultimately lead them to securing successful outcomes.

At Sir Thomas Wharton Academy we encourage all pupils to strive for 100% attendance: every day and every lesson counts.
